Dear Educators,

Welcome to this fun educational activity designed for children! The goal of the game is to learn the names of animals in three languages: Italian, English, and the Veneto dialect, through a hands-on activity of cutting and matching.

Enjoy this activity and explore the world of animals with the children in a creative and interactive way!

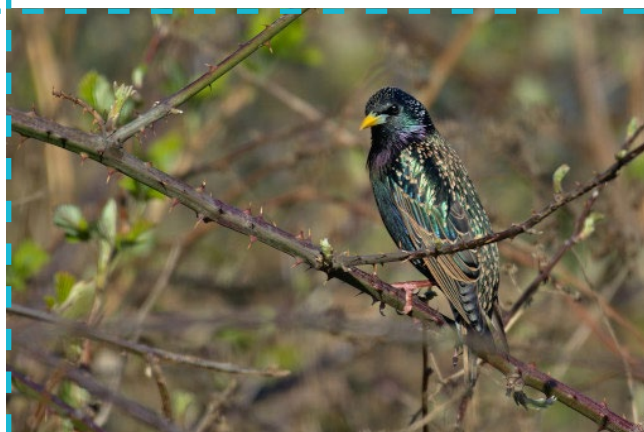
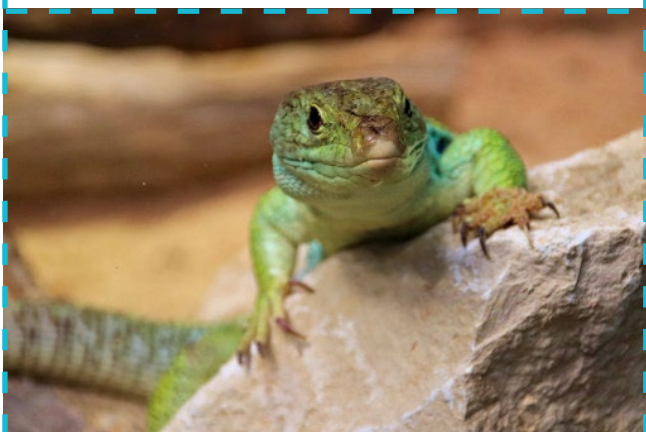
